Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was established in Portland, Oregon in 1943. They began as a small machine shop at first employing 4 individuals. Product sales for their first year of operation totaled \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless steel pipe fittings, valves and different components. During 5 years of operation, the company had expanded to forty employees and their yearly sales volume had increased to \$330,000. These days, Cascade is amongst the top worldwide makers within the material handling business.

Design and production of the company's original hydraulic cylinder allowed this young business to aggressively pursue new business opportunities. All through the final 60 years, the trade of material handling has grown into a really sophisticated field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its improvement. Cascade presently continues to grow as the premier provider of forklift attachments and different associated items. The business feels assured in their capability in order to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding customer's needs in the future and remaining competitive within the international market.

Through the 1950's, Cascade began to make, design, and promote its hydraulic accessories. A new facility was constructed in 1956, to be able to house all of the plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which is still the company's present headquarters. After fifteen years of business, total workers reached a hundred and eighty staff and sales had reached practically \$2,300,000.

In the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio a second production facility was built. 1960 marked Cascade's preliminary transfer into the global world of the material handling industry as the company established interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

The company altered its name to Cascade Corporation in 1964. In the year 1965, Cascade went public with a preliminary offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. The business has expanded its manufacturing plants throughout the United States with places in Portland, Oregon, Springfield, Ohio, and Warner Robins, Georgia. Cascade products are made internationally due to lots of subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a brand new facility was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This plant is designed to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Continuing to grow, Cascade expanded their product offering further in the year 1996 and 1997 with the impressive acquisition of five firms, along with the international best in forks, the Kenhar Corporation.
