Utility Bucket - Universal Fit buckets also called "slip-on-the-forks" lift truck attachment buckets. Since universal fit forklift buckets slip onto the forks directly, they stay on the equipment and are a lot less vulnerable to destruction. These buckets are even fifty percent deeper than the quick-tach bucket models. This additional room makes them perfect for carrying irregular shaped loads like elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls and tearing off roof trash.

A hardened beveled cutting blade on both sides and on the leading edge reinforces stability, resistance to wear and tear and provides supreme durability. Quick-Tach lift truck buckets can be utilized to substitute the carriage and forks which weigh between one hundred to seven hundred pounds. Once set up, these buckets free up more of the unit's load capacity, enabling it to deal with heavier and bigger items. The Quick-Tach is able to dump things more or less 1.5 feet higher due to the shorter depth of its bucket.
