Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriage - There are actually 4 sizings of hook type blade carriages rated by the blade carriage lifting capacity. Hook type blade carriages have been the same.

Class I carriages are rated for loads as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for cargo as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is twenty five inches.

Pin mounted tines vary by the amount of offset between the blade and the fork eye. Some makers will differ the carriages for pin type tines. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
