

Carriage for Forklift

Carriages and Carriage Parts - Rated by the tine carriage lifting capability, there are four sizes of hook type tine carriages. The hook type fork carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for loads up to 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for cargo as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for this capacity is 25 inches.

Pin mounted blades differ by the amount of offset between the tine and the fork eye. Different makers would differ the carriages for pin type forks. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
